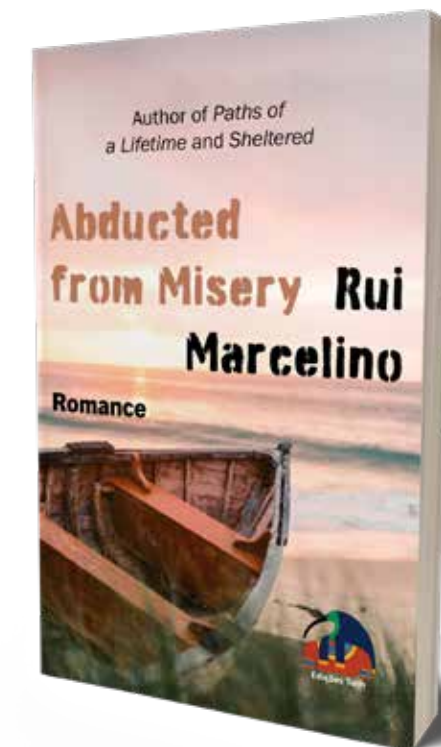
Engulfed in flames immediately after the accident, he had no time to see anything but the river, which had appeared right there in front of him, offering to save him. Would the others have been saved too?

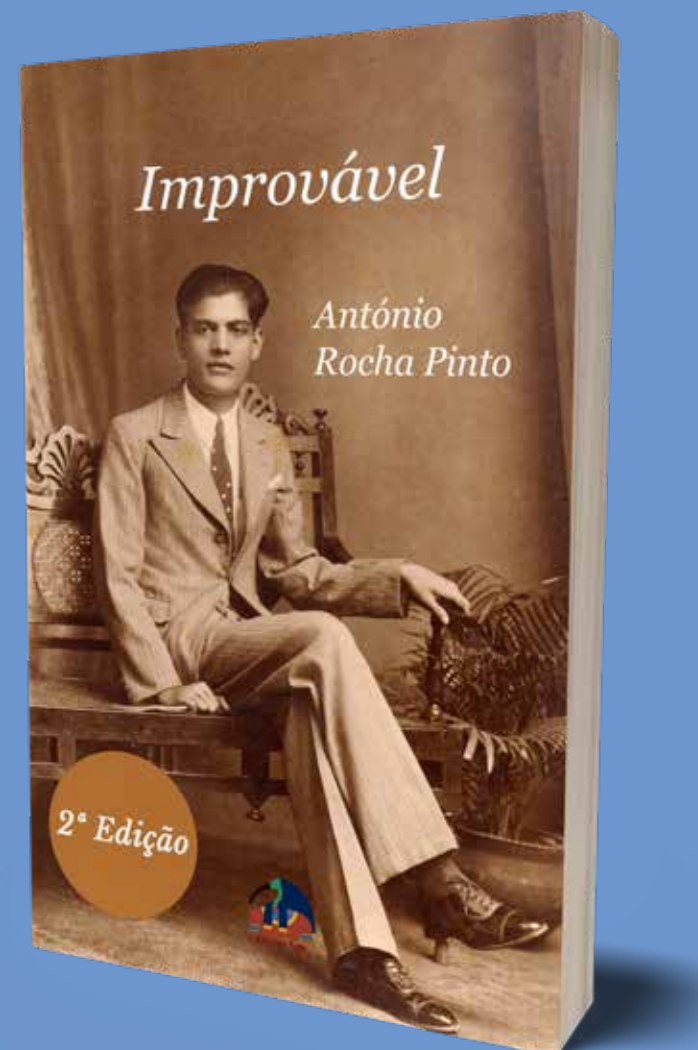

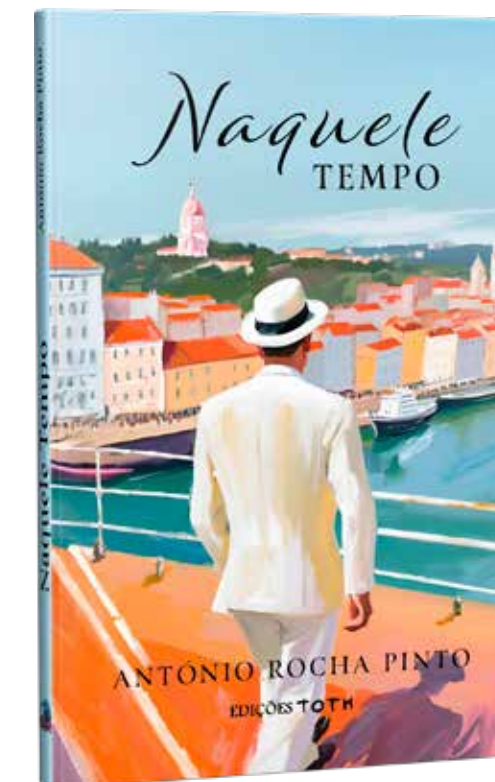
