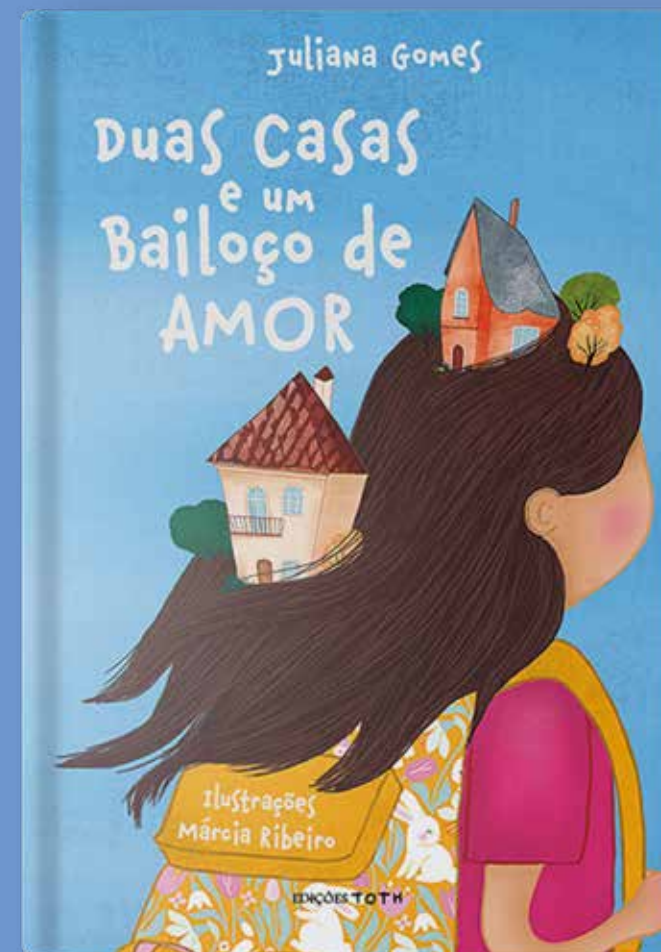

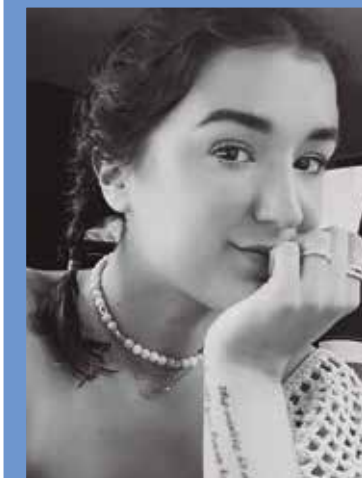


## Two Houses and a Love Swing

But the Evil King, upon seeing himself betrayed, will look for a way to take revenge.

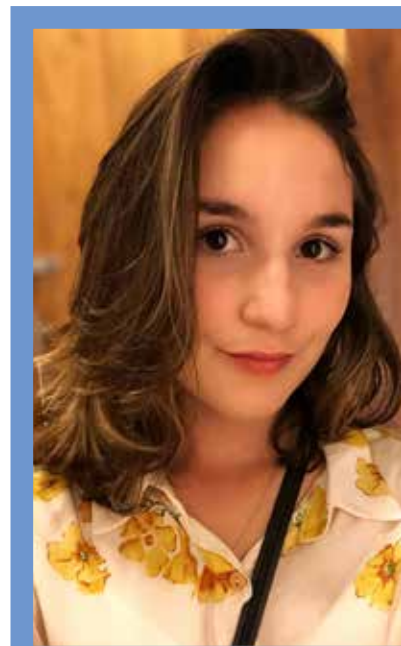
The secret services of the Imaginary Kingdom will always be alert, because

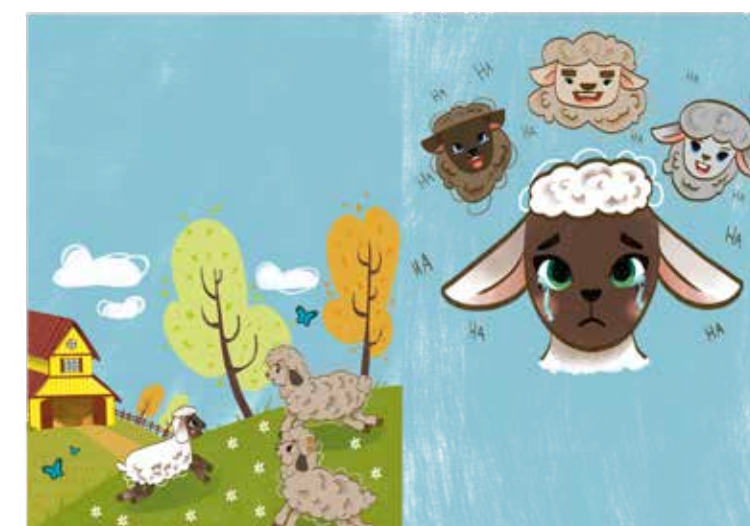
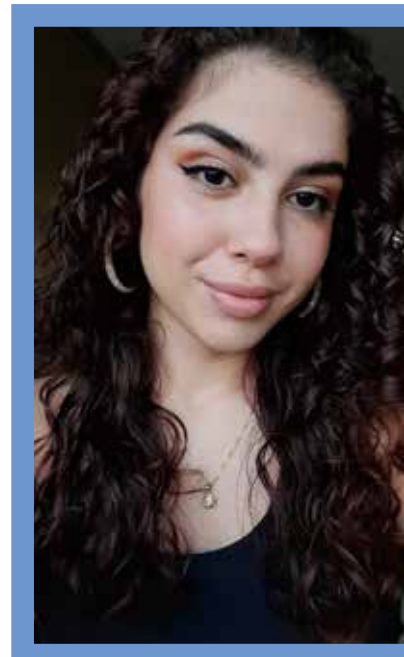

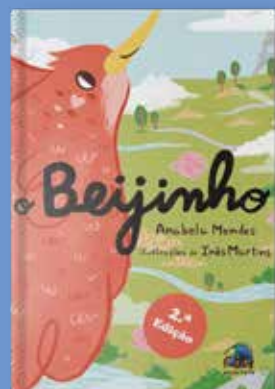
## ABOUT THE ILLUSTRATOR

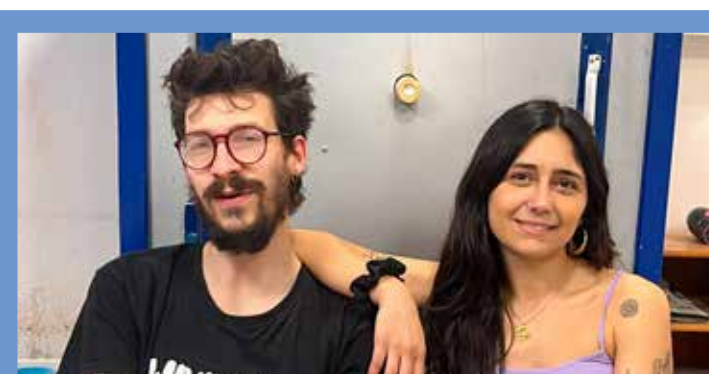

Mariana Jerónimo produces original ceramic pieces and children's illustrations, always with lots of color and organic shapes, always connected with nature. Miguel Fernandes teaches ceramics at Ateliê Cobalto, produces illustrations for the world of music and comics that tell his stories full of humor.
